To verify that you provided correct information the financial aid administrator at Rutgers University will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and all the appropriate parties must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to your regional Office of Financial Aid. NOTE: Rutgers University may ask for additional information. Promptly return this worksheet so that your financial aid is not delayed.
